ADULT (15-49 years) HUMANKIND HIV PREVALENCE STATUS at End-1999 RP Bernard, AF, Geneva Switzerland

Objective: Transform some Appendix-statistics of the UNAIDS-WHO REPORT on the global HIV/AIDS epidemic, June 2000, as made available to the delegates of the XIII International AIDS Conference in Durban, 9-14 July 2000 (red document rucksack) - into <u>AF MODULES</u> for study/teaching/ course work and decision makers(ing) - at all levels in all countries.

This has been executed in <u>42 modules</u> and released in successive steps in Nagpur, India (Vol 1, APRICA & ASIA/NARCHI-ICMCH, Nov 2000), then in <u>Geneva, Switzerland</u> (Vol 2, AMERICAS & EUROPE, AF, April 2001), then in <u>New York, USA</u> (Summary cover to 'Atlas' with 65 highest HIV density countries, with reprinted Vol 1 & 2), UNGASS-54, Special Session on HIV/AIDS, 25-27 June 2001, via Civil Society Conference. Meanwhile, 96% of 10'300 'World HIV DENSITY ATLAS, end-1999' were dispersed worldwide for modular teaching, cafeteria style. This is an excellent worldwide preparation for studying the next UNAIDS-WHO REPORT to be available at the XIV International AIDS Conference in Barcelona at mid-2002. Various centers will then know how to 'extract' from the Appendix-statistics and compose 'their-INTEREST' Tables and Charts.

A Conference Objective could be to extract from the <u>World Inventory</u> in Vol 1, pp 4-5 (n=167), some prevalence rates pertaining to Asia and in the context of some nations around the world. Here is such an exercise: ADULT HIV DENSITY multiples/quotients of <u>INDIA's HIV DENSITY</u> (70/10⁴ = 1]
